

HELP TO FEED YOUR CHILDREN

If your child received free/reduced price lunch at school and you don't receive SNAP, you should have received a P-EBT card in the mail for each of your children. The cards were mailed in May to the address your child's school uses to send you information and came in a plain white envelope with FIS as the return address.

- Each child was eligible for a total of \$377 for the months of April, May and June.
- If you did not receive a P-EBT card in the mail, call 2-1-1 or DHS at: 1-855-697-4347
- If you received the card, but lost it, call 1-888-979-9939 to get a new card. It will have the unspent amount of the benefit on it.
- It's not too late to get and use the card.
- It is safe to use the card. No information has been or will be reported to Immigration about families who use the card. There is no "public charge" problem with using the card.



If you received the card, but haven't used it yet, you can activate it and get benefits for April, May and June. To activate the card, call the number on the back of the card. You will need the EBT number on the front of the card, your zip code and the name and date of birth of the child on the card. You will need to set a 4 digit PIN that will you enter when you use the card at the grocery store.
