

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT USING EBT ONLINE

As of June 10, 2020 you can use your SNAP EBT Card to buy food online at the Walmart stores listed below and through Amazon. Some of the Walmart stores deliver food; others are pick-up only. Amazon is delivery-only. Here's information to help you decide about using this service.

Walmart Stores

North Smithfield	Yes	Yes– within 9-10 mile radius of store.*
Coventry	Yes	Yes – within 9-10 mile radius of store.*
Westerly	Yes	Yes– within 9-10 mile radius of store.*

Cranston	Beginning August 27	No
Warwick	Beginning September 29	No
Providence	Beginning September 29	No

* Delivery costs range from \$7.95 - \$9.95 depending on the time slot chosen for delivery. Unlimited delivery is also offered for a yearly fee of \$98.00 or \$12.95 per month. You cannot use your SNAP benefits to pay for the delivery cost. You need to charge to a RI Works cash EBT account or to a separate debit or credit card.

You can purchase fresh produce as well as other groceries.

- Order online.
- Delivery to home only. No pick up at Whole Foods
- You can purchase from Amazon Grocery (multi-pack sizes) or Amazon Pantry (regular sizes). Free shipping for Amazon Grocery on orders of \$35 or more (\$5.99 shipping fee on orders under \$35); free shipping for Amazon Pantry on orders of \$25 or more (delivery fee of between \$4.99 and \$9.99 depending on the time slot selected).
- You cannot use your EBT card to pay for the delivery costs or charge it to your RI Works cash EBT. You need to charge to a debit or credit card.
- You cannot purchase from Amazon Fresh.
